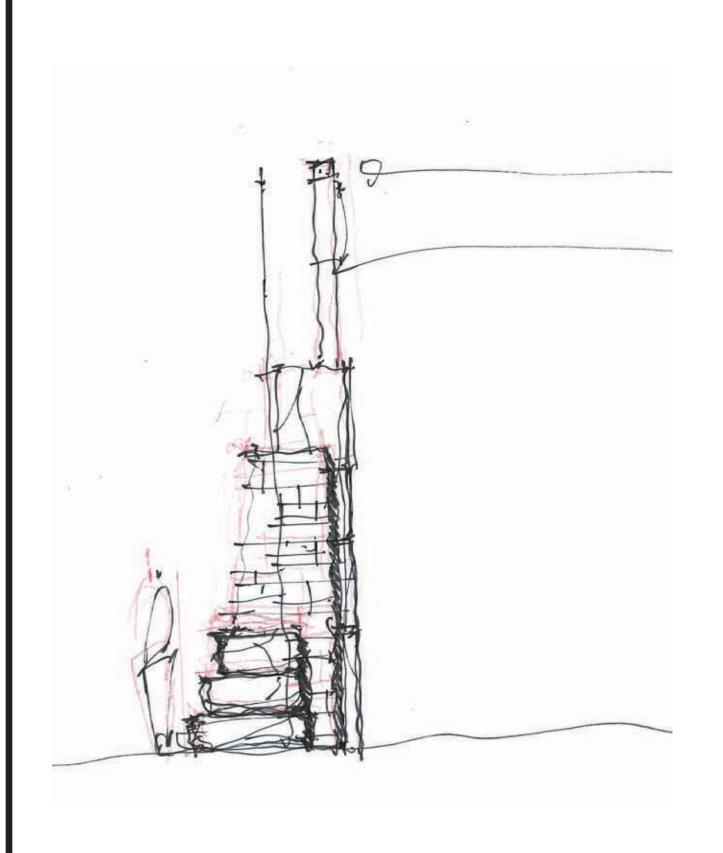
Preliminary Site Plan Concept

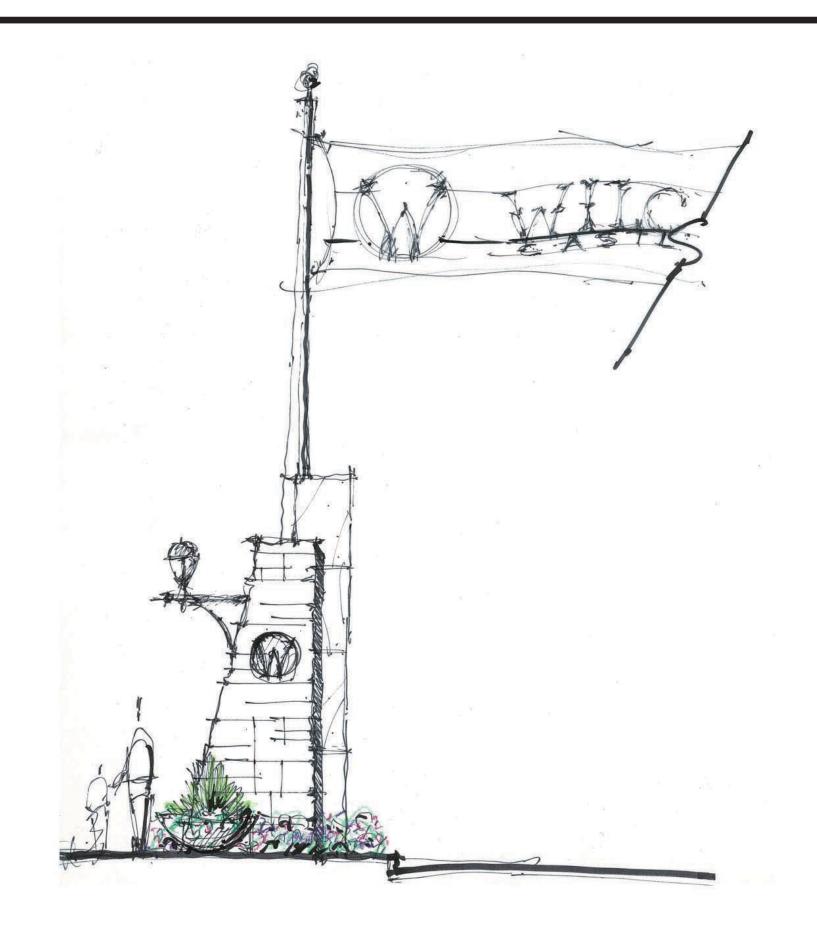

CASTLE ROCK ORIGIN GARDEN:

The structure of this garden is inspired by the six original streets (Elbert, Jerry, Wilcox, Perry, Castle, and Front) and the 77 lots that comprised Castle Rock at it's founding. The six streets are represented by pathways through the raised perennial garden beds that depict the 77 original lots that were designated in 1874. The Wilcox Street path is paved with concrete and aligned with the north entry to the Wilcox building.

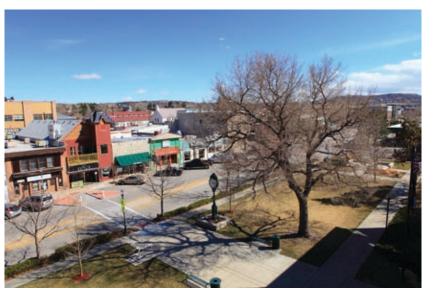

Good morning Judy.

In looking at the work to be done to implement the conversion at 309 Jerry street, we are thinking that the construction cost would be in the \$20,000 to \$25,000 range. This would include all elements such as the additional lanterns, awnings, and new windows. There could be cost saving measures if those last items were excluded from the scope.

Our fee to do the construction drawings and some minimal Construction Observation / working with the Contractor would be \$5,000.

This would include field measurements of existing conditions, a builder's set of documents (meaning a minimal set of drawings) and limited site observation.

We would anticipate the additional cost for resurfacing the north and south faces of the 309 Jerry street building to be as follow for approximately 1,300 SF of wall surface:

Option 1.

Fiber/ Concrete siding/ painting/ furring/ flashing: \$8,400

Ivy protection/ resetting north side \$500

Total \$8,900

Option 2

Prep and paint of existing brick. \$3,200

Ivy protection/ resetting north side \$500

Total \$3,700

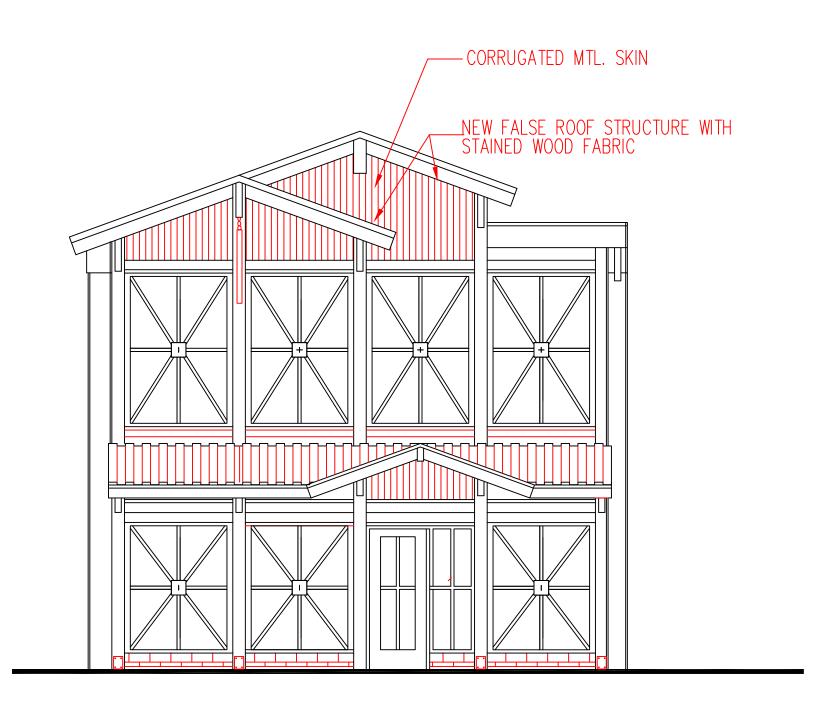
